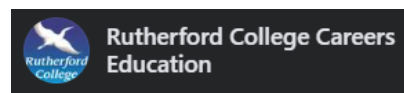

\*Full – Standard 29365 – 2 Level 2 credits

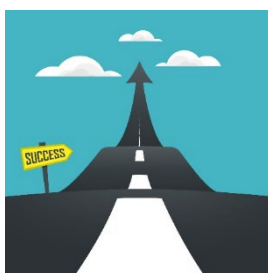
Credits from these standards can count towards NCEA.
